ABOUT OUR SESSIONS

UCAS and Admissions

This session will look at the UCAS application process including key dates, course choices and offers, as well as providing insightful admissions advice.

How to Choose

Reflecting on their individual preferences, attendees will explore expert advice on how to choose a course and institution.

Budgeting

Featuring advice from recent graduates, this session will explore ways to effectively budget and how to save money as a student.

Student Finance

This session explains facts and figures from higher education, including tuition fees, maintenance loans, grants and bursaries. Also available as Student Finance Northern Ireland

Study Skills and Independent Research

Providing advice on how best to study effectively, this session also helps students to identify their preferred method of learning and retaining information.

Time Management

Often juggling competing deadlines and priorities, students will leave this session more confident in managing their own time and priorities for study.

Next Steps

This session looks at the different options available to students post GCSE, including how decisions can affect progression to university, apprenticeships and employment.

Why go to University?

Looking at the advantages of a university education, students will explore how to make the right choice and what they can expect from student life.

Personal Statements

This session will explain the role and importance of Personal Statements in the admissions process and provide helpful advice on how to write one effectively.

Transitioning to University

Progressing to university can be a daunting experience, and this session will explain the range of support available to students and provide practical advice on what to expect.

Providing tailored support to those looking at study as a mature learner, this session addresses key areas of concern, and highlights specific funding available.

Tailored to one of these groups of students, this session provides an overview of the vibrant communities on campus, and top tips from current and recent students.

Ask an Expert: University Explained

Hosted by a knowledgeable member of our student recruitment team, this live session allows students to ask any questions they have about various aspects of university, including personal statements, UCAS and student finance.

Virtual Campus Tours

Our Virtual Tours provide an interactive, opportunity to see our beautiful campuses from the comfort of your own home, guided by a knowledgeable member of staff.

Personal Statements Drop-in

Providing an opportunity for students to have their Personal Statements reviewed in advance, this session would then feature a drop-in opportunity to discuss feedback and improvements with a member of the recruitment team.

Teacher Meetings: How Hope can support Teachers and Advisors

Individual meetings are available for staff within schools to discuss how Hope can support advisors with information and content, including delivery of these sessions.

H.E Landscape for Teachers

Designed for school staff, this session provides an overview of the current higher education landscape including legislative and regulatory changes.

Shaping Futures and Uni Connect

This presentation seeks to provide an understanding of Uniconnect, Shaping Futures and their aims. It also seeks to showcase the relationship that Liverpool Hope has with these organisations and what widening participation provision we offer as a result of the partnership.

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
